CHILDREN'S MESSAGE

Today we will be talking about kindness and how we treat others. Sometimes people are treated unkindly because they are different. People may look or act differently because God made each of us unique. It is important that we remember that God loves and specially made each person and we should love others with this same love.

[Show a tube of toothpaste]

Do you see this tube of toothpaste?

This tube of toothpaste represents unkind words and actions.

Now let's squeeze out some unkind words, or actions that leave others feeling sad or left out. Once we choose to say or act unkindly, those are forever imprinted on someone's heart. Just like we can't put the toothpaste back in the tube, the unkindness can never be undone.

God loves each of us the same and we should look at others with God's love. Let's remember to show kindness and treat others like we would want to be treated.

Let's Pray:

Dear God, thank you for your great love. Help us to remember to share that love and kindness. In Jesus name, Amen.
